**ORDER PROVIDING 24 CLAIMANTS THIRTY MORE  
DAYS TO SUBMIT MISSING FORMS OR BE DISQUALIFIED**

On May 12, 2008, the Claims Administrator for the Tolbert Qualified Settlement Fund (the "Fund"), advised the Court that (i) 2 minor claimants who have now reached 19 have not submitted an Advance Payment Form within 30 days after being requested in writing to do so; and (ii) 22 minor claimants who have now reached 19 have not provided other missing forms within 14 days after being requested in writing to do so.

The Claims Administrator recommends that these 24 claimants (the "Document Deficient Minors") be given 30 additional days to complete their forms or be suspended from the case, not being qualified to receive additional payments from the Fund.

The Court, having reviewed the Claims Administrator's Report and considered all other matters and things that are appropriate, it is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED as follows:

Each of the 24 Document Deficient Minors shall be provided a written request by the Claims Administrator within 10 days from the date of entry of this Order that he or she complete and provide the missing form or forms to the Claims Administrator within 30 days after the notice letter is mailed to the claimant by the Claims Administrator. The Document Deficient Minors shall also be notified of this last opportunity to receive payment by publication of notice in the Anniston Star on a Sunday as soon as practicable and by posting the Order on the Website home page. Any Document Deficient Minor who does not so timely provide the missing form or forms to the Claims Administrator shall be forever barred from admission to this case and from participation in the Settlement herein, absent a showing of good cause. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Document Deficient Minors who fail to submit the form or forms in time shall continue to be barred from filing any additional claims against the Defendants or the Released Parties with respect to the matters that are settled herein.
