**ORDER APPROVING THE FORMATION OF
THE WEST ANNISTON MEDICAL CLINIC, INC.**


On July 28, 2004, Edgar C. Gentle, III, the Settlement Administrator for the Tolbert Qualified Settlement Fund (the "Fund"), notified the parties of his intention to request Court authorization to form the West Anniston Medical Clinic, Inc., an Alabama non-profit corporation, for the purpose of establishing and operating the Medical Clinic as contemplated in the Court's September 9, 2003 Final Judgment And Order. The Settlement Administrator has informed the Court that no objection was received from the parties concerning his proposal. Upon reviewing the

proposal, and considering all of the facts and circumstances, it is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED as follows:

1. The Court hereby authorizes the Settlement Administrator to form the West Anniston Medical Clinic, Inc., to be an Alabama non-profit corporation, and to receive all payments due from the Defendants for the Medical Clinic; and

2. The Settlement Administrator is authorized to file the appropriate forms with the Internal Revenue Service to obtain tax-exempt status for the West Anniston Medical Clinic, Inc. under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.
